

MEDIA GUIDELINES



The USA TODAY Network has the exclusive media rights to the “Seacoast Media Group and USA TODAY Network 2024 Republican Presidential Candidate Town Hall Forum” taking place at the Exeter Town Hall in Exeter, New Hampshire and streaming on Seacoastonline.com, USA TODAY.com, USA TODAY YouTube, USA TODAY Network local sites and social media platforms from October 10-16, 2023 (the “Forum”).

In light of USA TODAY Networks’ exclusive rights to the Forum you may not broadcast, transmit, sell, license, give, barter, exchange or otherwise disseminate the Forum, or any portion thereof, regardless of whether USA TODAY Network supplied you the Forum or if the Forum or excerpts were supplied to you by other sources. Permission to use the Forum is only granted if the following restrictions are adhered to:

1) An appropriate, unobstructed, on-screen credit, (i.e., “Courtesy of USA TODAY Network”), must appear in the upper left- or right-hand corner of the screen during the entire Forum excerpt and the Forum excerpt must be introduced with an audio credit: “In a town hall forum on the USA TODAY Network’s Channels.” On radio, each excerpt must be introduced with the same audio credit.

2) During the seven (7) day period described in paragraph 4 below, you may not air more than a total amount of three minutes (3:00) of excerpts from the Forum in any one program (including video and audio).

3) The excerpt footage must be taped directly from USA

TODAY Network’s stream or obtained directly from USA TODAY Network and may not be obtained from any other source such as satellite, or other forms of transmission. Additionally, only excerpts that have been streamed by USA TODAY Network in their entirety may be used.

4) Under no circumstances may an excerpt of the Forum or portions thereof be used beyond the seven (7) day period beginning October 10, 2023 and continuing through October 16. No archiving is permitted.

5) You may use the complete Forum on the internet only by way of the video embed function on the USATODAY.com video player for as long as the USA TODAY Network makes the Forum available on its video player.

You must advise your affiliates, subscribers, and any other entities to which you provide the Forum or any excerpts thereof for broadcast of these restrictions. Forum excerpts may only be used in their local programming.
